Minutes of August, 2017: Nancy Kijewski motioned to approve minutes as read; Brenda Hope seconded, minutes were passed unanimously.

Precursillo (Nancy Kijewski) (Report attached)

Parish Reps: Folder created with pertinent info

Time to Build: Workshop is October 7 at Mt. Claret; registration set up on Event Brite to get accurate count of attendants for workshop materials. Parish Reps received email notice; mass mailing sent, committee will begin personal phone calls to encourage participation by community. Talks will be led by Suzanne Tamargo (Parish Rep) and James and Pam Diaz (Sponsor portion). Cecelia will order materials for the workshop from National.

Applications for November weekends: Two for the men's so far. Discussion was held about how to handle candidates who are not registered at a parish (far away Catholics). Conclusion was that Sponsor should work with Pastor of Sponsor's parish (making sure pastoral concerns are addressed) and if possible, a Spiritual Advisor. Parish Rep of sponsor's parish would also be involved.

The Technique talk will be presented by Postcursillo and the Doctrinal talk will be Essentials and Incidentals; presented by Deacon Kevin Napp from St. Mary Magdalene.

Marty will talk to Rector/Rectora about attending follow up of upcoming weekends to do short presentation about School of Leaders.

Marty is continuing his personal outreach calls to Cursillistas.

Secretary (Cecelia Dusold)

Cecelia asked Nancy if she would synthesize her SOL report from September 5 into an article for one of the upcoming issues. Website: There was discussion about the privacy of the Financial Information of the Diocese of Phoenix Cursillo movement and of the Parish Rep phones/emails. It was agreed that an easily accessible password would be used to get into certain pages of the website. All Cursillistas would be given the password which would be some deterrent against people not associated with Phoenix Cursillo from accessing that information.
