Meeting opened at 6:30 pm with Leader's Prayer and Group Reunion

Minutes of September, 2017: Sharon Matson motioned to approve minutes as read; Nancy Kijewski seconded, minutes were passed unanimously.

Section Reports

Flagstaff (Vince Johnson – not present)

Men and Women's Teams are starting formation for weekends in Spring; they are working with smaller teams and more in kitchen so kitchen team can spend more time in Adoration.

Precursillo (Nancy Kijewski) (Report attached)

Time to Build Workshop - Thank you notes to all attendees; electronic rosters and corrected applications to be sent to all Parish Reps who attended Time to Build

Some reflection: Reps are looking for practical information more than theoretical info; good sharing and feedback in groups; feedback/Questions were recorded and attached to this report

Discussion was held whether Group Reunion should be held at every Cursillo event; general consensus was most events should start with the friendship group reunion and look at it on a case by case basis.

Possibility of east and west side Parish Rep groups to share and assist each other

Applications - One applicant has not received Confirmation; application was old (prior to the Bishop's request that all candidates have been confirmed) and has been signed by Pastor; Ruben will be meeting with Bishop and will ask him to clarify the requirement which is different than the National requirement.

Because the pastor at St. Bernadette has recently passed, applications will be handled by the interim Pastor Father Felt (Fr. Felt is a Cursillista).

Rector/Rectoras 2018

Women's February – Veronica Lucas Men's January – No Rector yet; "no's" have not been because of timing, not disinterest.

Clarifying Adoration for the Weekend

Ultimate goal is for team and candidates to be fully cloistered from community; there is a recognized need for the community to be in Adoration at Mt. Claret on the weekend, which the Bishop honors. Three-Day committee, noting frustration in community of clear guidance, requested that we avoid the problem of changes from weekend to weekend in this process and work towards a solution that becomes the norm for every weekend.

Conclusions:

Teams will need to be larger to accommodate all hours of adoration with extra kitchen members as a prayer team

The candidates and team will have Visitation of the Reposed Sacrament in the Chapel

Community Adoration of the Exposed Sacrament will be held in the Community Center from Thursday evening after the Opening until Sunday at 12 noon. Sponsors will still have the option to go to the parish of their choice for Adoration on the weekend. The Rector/Rectora will be ultimately responsible to ascertain that all hours are covered, but hopefully the team will not have to go to the Center. Three-Day is contacting previous Rectors/Rectoras asking them to contact their teams/new Cursillistas and group brothers/sisters to cover Adoration Hours. Secretariat must also sign up too. The Spiritual Directors will be in charge of Exposition/Reposition of the Sacrament.

Adoration sign up should be available all year; some sort of app should be online.
