School of Leaders: Marty Sprinzl

Core team retreat meeting had a meeting. The focus will be on Three essentials. Proposed date is July 14th. The other date available is July 28th. The rollista search continues. Some names were suggested by the secretariat members. The retreat will be open to all, with special invitations for potential core team members.

Fr. Hanningan is available for Mass at the retreat.

SOL group reunions are good, topic discussion is active. Still an ongoing struggle to find presenters for the doctrinal portions.

Looked at National website articles. Marty attached the article with the reminder for the SOL. Most had read the article and were prepared for the discussion. April's topic will be Friendship in the Cursillo.

Doctrinal part will shift to the Fr. David Knight Spiritual Formation program referring to his other book "His Way".

Posed the question about what should happen if a Cursillo is cancelled. Should the team be dissolved. Approximately 15-20 4th day Cursillistas were polled none agreed that the team should be disbanded. During discussions, the number of Cursillos and the method of scheduling Cursillos (after applications have been collected) came up. Rather than take a vote at this time, research needs to be done and future discussion need to be held to prevent the situation from occurring.

Brenda Halpain shared a team formation program from Georgia she learned about. They invite new Cursillistas to 4 Specialized school of leaders 4 weeks in a row to qualify for a team. Perhaps similar to Basic School that used to be here in Phoenix.

Ruben asked about the number of Candidates should be on a weekend. Tabled to next month for more research.

Marty suggested that the Saturday SOL in July be a cleaning date for the St. Agnes cafeteria as a thank you. Tuesday night in July is the day before the holiday so it will be cancelled. Tuesday night in July in lieu of a secretariat meeting we will clean the office.
