- ❖ We will be hosting "A Time to Build" Parish Representative Forum and Sponsor's Workshop on Saturday, October 7. All parish reps, new and experienced, will receive information and materials to assist them with their promotion and organization of the Cursillo Movement on a parish level. School of Leaders is an opportunity to meet and learn with other Cursillistas who want to help guide the future of our Movement.
